

**Manitoba Lacrosse Association  
Traveling Team  
Travel Agreement**

This agreement is between the **Manitoba Lacrosse Association** and ----- . For the purposes of this agreement the terms:

- **“Team”** will designate the ----- which is defined as players, coaches, managers, and team officials.

**A. CLA Rules for National Championships/National Invitational/Inter-Provincial Tournaments**

Which include but are not limited to:

- Coaching certification – Head Coach will be fully certified as per the CLA minimum level Lacrosse Coaching Certification levels. All bench personnel must be certified as per the CLA minimum level Lacrosse Coaching Certification levels. If a trainer is part of the bench personnel, they must have completed a trainer’s program or equivalent.

**B. MLA Performance Bond with CLA**

The MLA has maintained its permanent bond of \$2000 with the Canadian Lacrosse Association. The **“Team”** agrees to reimburse the MLA an amount up to \$2000 of the performance bond if the following transpires:

- The team commits to participating in the **“Tournament”** (entry fee paid, roster submitted to the MLA) and subsequently withdraws from the competition.
- The team commits any offense that violates the CLA Code of Conduct which subsequently results in the forfeiture of any part or all of the MLA performance bond.
- The amount of penalty, where warranted, will be determined by the CLA and/or MLA.

**C. Funding Agreements and Expectations**

- In the event the MLA provides any form of funding, the **“Team”** will be responsible for the full accounting of all revenue received. Revenue may be expended on air or ground transportation and hotel accommodations. Receipts supporting these allowed expenditures must be submitted to the MLA ten (10) days from the date of return from the tournament.

**D. MLA Membership**

- As per the MLA Constitution and By-Laws, all members of the **“Team”** must be properly registered with the MLA and membership fees paid. This includes players, coaches, managers and officials of the team
- Players not properly registered will be considered in bad standing and will not be eligible to participate in the **“Tournament”** until such time they have properly registered and paid their membership fee.

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**E. Authorization**
