Registration fee is a prerequisite to begin the course.

Participants are to bring a pen and paper for classroom sessions and lacrosse stick and runners for practical on floor sessions.

The Canadian Lacrosse Association and Manitoba Lacrosse have instituted minimum-coaching standards for all disciplines in lacrosse. Coaches must obtain the “minimum standard” that is required for the age group they will be coaching. This Community Development clinic incorporates both technical and theory.

All coaches (Head and Assistants) participating in MLA sanctioned programs (Winnipeg Minor, Prairie Lacrosse League, Thompson Lacrosse, High School Field Lacrosse, Provincial Box and Field programs) must be registered members of the MLA and pay the \$20.00 annual membership fee. Coaches who are not certified at their required minimum standard and who have not paid their MLA membership fee are not eligible to be on the bench.
